BILLED BOOK-READING:

Schools write a cheque payable to *AnnBee Press Inc.* due at the beginning of the booked time. An invoice will be brought to the school and given upon receipt of payment.

Coming soon, schools may add the hands-on option to their book reading choice. In anticipation of the hands-on option, your school has children bring in a cardboard box to school. Lori Callaghan reads to the classes as per your time choice and then interacts with the students while they create cardboard box adventures. Teachers supervise. A large space is needed. The school uses their markers, paper, glue, etc. to add details to the cardboard box adventures. Soon, schools will have the opportunity for Gogglz to come into the school (in costume) to play with the children for this hands-on option! Stay tuned as we get the costume created. 😊
